The 2x Production Staff members will work together to deliver the production smoothly and ensure audiences have positive experiences. The roles will split duties across two clear areas:

Production: leading production fit up, maintaining installed illustrations, equipment maintenance, cleaning and troubleshooting delivery throughout the performance run.

Audience management: working closely with the venue front of house team to support audience access requirements, giving pre-show briefings and troubleshooting delivery throughout the performance run.

- Attend training and familiarisation sessions with staff from IAP and the presenting venue
- Oversee COVID safety protocols for audience and equipment
- Actively manage production equipment (mp3 players, headphones): cycling, cleaning and resources with audience
- Actively manage audience requirements, BSL, access and equipment and venue quiet space
- Support audience with all performance content, map and route queries
- Jointly supervise live operations and liaise with venue on Box Office numbers/capacities and audience movement
- Be a point of contact for audience out on the route if they encounter challenges
- Complete a nightly show report and send to IAP company members
